

How to read eBooks/eAudiobooks on a mobile device?

- Download any of the apps listed below from the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android).
- Open the app, search for **Lake Mac Libraries** and login with your **Library card number** and **PIN**.
- You may also be prompted to sign up with your email address.
- Browse, borrow and begin reading.

Can I download eBooks to my eReader?

- Yes, some of our providers support downloads to an eReader – check the table below for compatibility.
- BorrowBox and Indyreads content can be downloaded to your eReader via Adobe Digital Editions.

Do I need to connect to WiFi?

- Yes, a mobile internet or WiFi connection is required to borrow and download titles.
- Once your eBook has downloaded in full, eBooks/eAudiobooks can be read or listened to offline.

Returns

- Manually return your loans early when you have finished reading.
- Otherwise, content will be automatically returned and removed on the expiry date.
