

eLibrary FAQs

How do I use eLibrary content on a mobile device?

- Download any of the apps listed below from the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android).
- Once downloaded, select Lake Mac Libraries and login with your library card number and PIN. You
 may need to create an account using your email address first.

How do I use eLibrary content on an eReader?

 eReaders that support the ePub file type can be used to read ebooks – you must download them to a computer first and transfer to your eReader using Adobe Digital Editions.

Do I need to connect to WiFi?

- A mobile Internet or WiFi connection is required to borrow and download titles.
- Once titles have been downloaded in full, eBooks and eAudiobooks can be read or listened to offline.

Loan period and loan limits

- For applicable loan periods, refer to the table below.
- BorrowBox reservations and renewals are regarded as loans and contribute to your loan limit count.
- Hoopla and Pressreader items are always available and do not need to be reserved.
