

## How do I use eLibrary content on a mobile device?

- Download any of the apps listed below from the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android).
- Once downloaded, select **Lake Mac Libraries** and login with your **library card number** and **PIN**. You may need to create an account using your email address first.

## How do I use eLibrary content on an eReader?

- eReaders that support the ePub file type can be used to read ebooks – you must download them to a computer first and transfer to your eReader using Adobe Digital Editions.

## Do I need to connect to WiFi?

- A mobile Internet or WiFi connection is required to borrow and download titles.
- Once titles have been downloaded in full, eBooks and eAudiobooks can be read or listened to offline.

## Loan period and loan limits

- For applicable loan periods, refer to the table below.
- BorrowBox reservations and renewals are regarded as loans and contribute to your loan limit count.
- Hoopla and Pressreader items are always available and do not need to be reserved.
